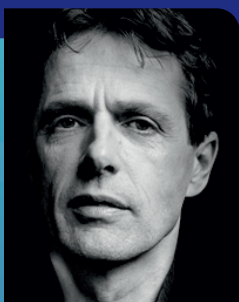

Niek van Dijk, MD, PhD NED

Cornelis Nicolaas "Niek" van Dijk is an orthopaedic surgeon, a specialist in sports traumatology and arthroscopic surgery of the ankle and knee. Until 2016 Van Dijk was Full Professor in Orthopaedics and head of the Orthopaedic Department at the AMC-hospital in Amsterdam (Academic Medical Centre, University of Amsterdam). He continues his career in the FIFA Medical Centres of excellence in Madrid and Porto. He is the founder of a characteristic approach, which has come to be known as the Amsterdam Foot & Ankle School (aka The Amsterdam Approach).



Jón Karlsson, MD, PhD SWE

Jón Karlsson is Professor of Orthopaedics and Sports Traumatology at the Sahlgrenska Academy, Gothenburg University, Gothenburg, Sweden. Originally from Iceland, he has worked at Sahlgrenska University Hospital since 1981. His clinical focus is knee surgery, especially complex knee injuries, knee dislocations and revision surgery. He is also involved in Foot & Ankle surgery, hip surgery, muscle & tendon repair/reconstructive surgery, as well as trauma care.

His PhD-thesis in 1989 was devoted to "Chronic Lateral Ankle Instability", and since then he has been the author of more than 600 peer-reviewed publications, more than 150 book chapters and over 40 textbooks in Orthopaedics and Sports Traumatology.

He was executive Board Member of ISAKOS between 2005 and 2019. He is regular lecturer at the IOC Advanced Team Physician Course

He has mentored 70 PhD-students at the Sahlgrenska Academy. He is currently (since 13 years) the chief Editor of KSSTA (Knee Surgery Sports Traumatology Arthroscopy), the official journal of ESSKA. He has a past position as Associate Editor of Scandinavian Journal of Medicine and Science in Sports (SJMSS), (1997-2003) and Arthroscopy (2003-2008). He has been the care-taking physician of a professional football club (IFK Göteborg) since 1984.



Vytautas Kimtys, MD LTU

Vytautas Kimtys is working in the The Hospital of Lithuanian University of Health Sciences (LSMU) Kauno klinikos which is the largest healthcare institution in Lithuania. He is an orthopaedic surgeon, specialized in Foot and Ankle. His practice is focused on the treatment of ankle injuries and pathologies, using arthroscopic techniques.

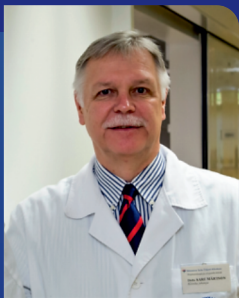

Orthopaedic Society and Estonian Arthralpalsty Society is part of everyday local and international social work.



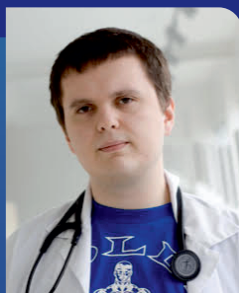
